School and Community

Stafford High School is a four year college preparatory public high school in Stafford Springs, Connecticut, with an enrollment of approximately 400 students. The high school operates on a 181 day academic calendar. Students attend school for 6 ½ hours per day, and maintain 6 credits per year.

The town of Stafford Springs is a rural-suburban community with a population of approximately 12,000 residents. It is located 27 miles northeast of Hartford, CT and about 30 miles southeast of Springfield, Ma. Stafford is also in close proximity to Providence, RI and Boston, MA.

Academic Program

Our program is driven by our Core Values, Beliefs, and Learning Expectations. Stafford High School, in partnership with students, families and the community strives to nurture learners that are productive, responsible, independent, and dedicated to excellence. We develop informed members of the 21st Century global society and expect the highest character, integrity, respect, cultural understanding, and ethical behavior. We provide a safe, supportive, and challenging learning environment in which students have the opportunity to learn in ways that best meet their needs, and can work collaboratively to solve problems and accomplish goals.

Highlights of the Academic Program

- Dual-enrollment courses are offered to all students and are completed by 40% of graduates on average
- Work experiences are available to all students through established school-community partnerships with local businesses and organizations
- On average, 20% of graduates complete at least one AP course
